


Forci is a multifaceted family project — a Regenerative

Tuscan Farmhouses

Eleven farmhouses within the estate, each one differing in size and each with its individual characteristics, will be offered for sale. Each property will be sold with several hectares of farm land and comes with an approved renovation project. Buyers will find 3 types of farmhouse projects with several levels of renovations:



Entry Level

The entry-level projects with minimally necessary renovation

Mid-size

The mid-size projects requiring a higher level of renovation, but little structural work

C

High level

The high-level projects with important structural work

The Project Coordination team at Forci would be available to work with potential buyers to select the type of property and the type of project that is best suited to them, to the property and to their budget, within the framework of the historic preservation guidelines.

Embracing Regenerative Agriculture

By following the principles of regenerative agriculture and "re-booting" the Forci farm in a smart way based on permaculture design, Forci aims to create and maintain a self-sustaining ecosystem with as little human interference as possible. Biodynamic wine, biological olive oil, new antique fruit orchards, "food forests" designed on the basis of permaculture, and slowly introducing free range farm animals will support the family's effort to find the right balance in order to give back more to nature.

Your Personal Tuscan Farm

One of the captivating highlights of owning a house at Forci lies in the generous provision of 1-4 hectares of land dedicated to each homeowner, offering certain planting possibilities and a true connection to nature. Owners will have the option to collaborate with the Forci farm team and include an herb garden, more olive trees, some fruit trees and bushes. Imagine having access to an abundance of fresh, homegrown fruits and vegetables right on your doorstep!

Community Building and Sharing

At Forci, the spirit of community is fostered by sharing the abundant harvest. Homeowners have the opportunity to connect with their neighbors and engage in activities such as meals and harvesting events. These shared moments in nature not only strengthen the bonds within the community, but also cultivate a sense of pride in the shared achievements of sustainable living.

Sustainable Design

Forci offers homeowners an option to support them in renovating and designing houses based on Regenerative/Circular Construction Principles such as reusing materials, embracing renewable energy sources, focusing on efficient insulation, re-using grey water, and collecting rain water. Our goal is to assist homeowners to create beautiful, comfortable, and environmentally-friendly homes, while making responsible choices and minimizing waste for a brighter future.



The Location & Neighborhood

Forci is located in Tuscany, north-west of the historic centre of Lucca, in the area of Pieve Santo Stefano, which has always been the most desirable hill in the area, both for its unspoilt and restorative nature and the breathtaking views that extend as far as the sea.

Forci is only 8 km from the historic centre of Lucca, 35 km from the coast of Versilia, where we find both towns of art and culture such as Pietrasanta and beach locations such as Forte dei Marmi, only 40 km from the international airport of Pisa and 80 km from Florence.

The charming town of Lucca is renowned for its rich history, stunning architecture, and picturesque surroundings. The neighborhood of Lucca offers a wonderful blend of cultural heritage and modern amenities, making it a sought-after place to live.
